Registration

All players are required to check in with the Pro Shop before starting their round of golf.

All members must register their guests and pay the appropriate fees before play.

Schedule of Play

The Golf Course Superintendent shall decide when the course is open and when golf cart usage is restricted. Under normal conditions, the course will follow the schedule in the middle column during the golf season.

Golf Course Rules

All play is governed by the rules of golf as published and enforced by the United States Golf Association. All questions pertaining to rules interpretations will be directed to the Golf Professional.

All players should start from #1 tee. You must obtain permission from the Pro Shop to start from anywhere else on the course. Faster groups shall have preference over slower groups.

Golf etiquette demands that slower groups invite faster groups to play through. This should always be done when there is one clear hole ahead of the slower group.

Driving Range and Golf Carts

8:00 a.m. to dusk

The driving range closes early on Sundays and Thursdays.

Women have scheduled tee times on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.

Playing times are subject to change due to tournaments, outside groups or special events. Notices of such changes will be posted in the Chatter and/or will be posted in the Pro shop and both locker rooms.

Golf Course Rules (con't)

Fivesomes are allowed. Sixsomes are allowed on **Wednesdays only** April 1st – October 1st. Sixsomes are allowed at the discretion of the Pro Shop in the off-season and other days.

Please repair all ball marks on the greens and replace your divots. If the divot is not replaceable, use sand.

Under no circumstance shall the golf course be used as a practice range. There is a driving range for this purpose.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the course other than those purchased at the Club.

Please use no more than one towel.

Members and/or their guests are held responsible for any damage done to the property of Lawrence Country Club.

Pets are not allowed on the golf course.

Non-golf use of the golf course during golfing hours is prohibited. This includes walking, jogging and bicycling.

These rules are for the benefit of all LCC members. You are encouraged to enforce these rules, and you may report any infraction of these rules to the Pro Shop.

Violation of Golf Course Rules will result in:

- 1st Violation** – verbal reminder of the rule.
- 2nd Violation** – letter from the Board or Golf Committee.
- 3rd Violation** – subject to suspension.

Golf Carts

Operators of golf carts must have a valid drivers license. Only two riders are permitted per cart.

Operation of a golf cart is at the risk of the operator. Members using a cart will be held fully responsible for any and all damages caused by the use of the cart by members or their guests.

Carts must stay on paths on all par threes. Otherwise, use the 90 degree rule and follow all signage. This rule also applies to motorized hand carts.

Carts are rented on a first-come first-served basis. The Pro shop is not allowed to reserve carts.



Guest Policy

Each guest is limited to play four times per calendar year at the stated guest fee rate, regardless of whom they play with or how their rounds are paid for. Members may use their Stockholder passes for their guests. After a guest has played four times, the greens fees for any subsequent rounds will be \$200 per round plus cart. If a guest plays in the Member-Guest Tournament, the Ladies Invitational, Pro-Am, or Guest Day, those rounds will not count toward their four rounds.

Immediate family members receive 50% off greens fees. This includes parents and siblings of members.

House Guest*

* House Guest – any guest who lives 25+ miles outside of Lawrence and staying with a member for an extended period of time.

Starting Time Procedure

Tee times are recommended for preference on the first tee.

Tee times can be made up to seven days in advance by non-Stockholders and fourteen days by Stockholders.

Tee times are in effect for the entire year.

Dress Code

Proper golf attire, including shirts and shoes, is required at all times on the golf course and practice areas. No jeans or denim will be allowed on the golf course or practice areas from April 1st to September 30th. Children will be governed by the same rules of attire as adults. Gentlemen must wear slacks or shorts, and appropriate golf shirts. Ladies must wear appropriate golf tops and skirts, slacks, or shorts. The following items of apparel are not permitted: non-dress T-shirts, tank tops, cutoffs, gym or jogging shorts, tennis or other athletic shorts, sweat pants, bathing suits, halter or tube tops, or other attire deemed inappropriate by the Pro Shop. Shoes with steel or ceramic spikes are not permitted on the golf course or practice areas. Any misuse or disregard of these rules may cause privileges to be reviewed or suspended.
