*The Golf Shop will be open at least one hour prior to the first tee time.*

*The "40 degree" rule will be in effect year-round. LCC will use weather.com as the official temperature.*

*Women have scheduled tee times on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.*

*Playing times are subject to change due to tournaments, outside groups or special events.*

*Notices of such changes will be posted in the Chatter and/or will be posted in the Golf Shop and both locker rooms.*

**Registration:**

All players are required to check in with the Golf Shop before starting their round of golf for both 9 and 18 holes.

All members must register their guests and pay the appropriate fees before play.

**Starting Time Procedure:**

Tee times are recommended for preference on the first tee. Tee times can be made up to seven days in advance by non-stockholders and fourteen days by stockholders. Tee times are in effect for the entire year.

**Schedule of Play:**

The Golf Course Superintendent shall decide when the course is open and when golf cart usage is restricted. Under normal conditions, the course will follow the schedule in the middle column during the golf season.

**Golf Course Rules:**

All play is governed by the rules of golf as published and enforced by the United States Golf Association. All questions pertaining to rules interpretations will be directed to the Golf Professional.

All players should start from #1 tee. You must obtain permission from the Golf Shop to start from anywhere else on the course. The faster groups shall have preference over the slower groups.

Golf Etiquette demands that slower groups to invite faster groups to play through. This should always be done when there is one clear hole ahead.

Groups of five are allowed. Groups of six are allowed on **Wednesdays only** April 1<sup>st</sup> - October 1<sup>st</sup>. At all times, groups of six are to the Pro's discretion.

Please repair all ball marks on the greens. The Superintendent asks that you replace your divots. If the divot is not replaceable, use sand.

Under no circumstance shall the golf course be used as a practice range.

**No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the course other than those purchased at the Club.**

Members and/or their guests are held responsible for any damage they do the property of the Lawrence Country Club.

Pets are not allowed on the golf course.

**Guest Policy:**

Each guest is limited to play four times per calendar year at the stated guest fee rate, regardless of who they play with or how their rounds are paid for. Members may use their stockholder passes for their guests if they wish. After the guest has played four times, the greens fees for any subsequent rounds will be \$200 per round plus cart. If the guest plays in the Member-Guest Tournament, the Ladies Invitational, the Pro-Am or on a "Guest Day", those rounds will not count toward their four rounds.

**House Guest\***

*House Guest – any guest who lives 25+ miles outside of Lawrence and staying with a member for an extended period of time.*

**Dress Code:**

Proper golf attire, including shirts and shoes, is required at all times on the golf course and practice areas. No jeans or denim will be allowed on the golf course or practice areas from April 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>. Children will be governed by the same rules of attire as adults. Gentlemen must wear slacks or shorts, appropriate golf shirts. Ladies must wear appropriate golf tops and skirts, slacks, or shorts. The following items of apparel are not permitted: non-dress T-shirts, tank tops, cutoffs, gym or jogging shorts, tennis or other athletic shorts, sweat pants, bathing suits, halter or tube tops, or other attire deemed inappropriate by the Golf Professional. Shoes with steel or ceramic spikes are not permitted on the golf course or practice areas.

*These rules are for the benefit of all LCC members. You are encouraged to enforce these rules, and you may report any infraction of these rules to the Golf Shop. Any misuse or disregard of these rules may cause privileges to be reviewed or suspended.*
